



PRESIDENTS MESSAGE:

We have a lot to be grateful for as the official support group of University of Nebraska Rowing. Since 2017 tremendous accomplishments have been realized. Accomplishments include: Relocating to Pawnee Lake, construction of secure shell storage and a building for warmups, workouts and equipment storage. Shell trailer rehabbed and a new paint job by Duncan Aviation, new dock installed by Camus Rec. Team size has grown to 20 athletes with a goal of about 40 for 2024. Team racing included regional regattas and national championships.

We have financially supported a Head Coach and Assistant Coach that continues to grow the program in a competitive and safe manner. The Committees of Friends of Nebraska Rowing are setting up a sustainable future by establishing long term templates. The biggest priority for 2024 is to grow the Coaching Salary Fund. The next goal will be to grow the Coaching Endowment for long term future salaries. Our challenge is to generate approximately \$70,000 in this next year for current Coaching Salaries and to prepare for the next year. The University of Nebraska Foundation continues to provide guidance and tax free donation assistance and accounts. Keep Growing with Rowing...for a lifetime. Athlete Updates :

The Nebraska Crew rowed through another great semester this 2023 Spring Season. Before the boats hit the water, our crew trained rigorously this winter and added several indoor Races in Creighton, NE and Wichita, KS. After the ice melted, our team had two weeks before hosting K-State Rowing and Colorado State University here at Pawnee Lake. We enjoyed the scrimmage between the teams and seeing the enthusiasm for Rowing as the team connected with spectators. After hosting the scrimmage, our team raced at the Illinois Collegiate Rowing Invitational and the Plains Regional Regatta. Our Varsity Women's four continued training and competed at ACRA National Championships. The boat included Eleanor Dunning, Abigail Henderson, Abby Steffen, Katie Orr, and Kiara Pavlik. We took pride in representing Nebraska at this event and placed 18th out of 27 teams. Kiara Pavlik was recognized as the 1st Alternate for the MidWest Regional Boat. We said goodbye to three graduates: Jonathan Kelly, Katie Orr, and Regis Yizerwe. We are thankful for their contribution to the University of Nebraska-Lincoln Rowing program and wish them well in their next pursuits Our goal is to increase our crew membership through heavy recruitment and strategies for effective practices that increase our competitiveness. The first competition on our calendar is the Head of the Mississippi in Minneapolis, MN. We will attend several more competitions before closing our outdoor season with Frostbite in Wichita, KS. The Nebraska Crew is focused and excited for our next steps this fall!

Summer 2023 High School Learned to Row

UNL hosted a learn-to-row event this summer for high school students. The clinic for high school students in Lincoln and surrounding areas included a two-day rowing clinic is designed as an introduction to rowing.

Perspective oarsmen and women were provided a crash course on the parts of the boat and spend some time working on technique and developing power when rowing. They spent most of the morning rowing on the water with current and former crew members guiding them as they develop their rowing form.

During his three years at Nebraska, his parents, Robin and Randy Ruhl, traveled to every regatta with a car full of snacks for the team, and even sent boxes of snacks with us for Spring break training. They started doing so after attending the 2010 Head of the Des Moines and seeing that we had nothing to eat between races and became a regular fixture at regattas from the next race (Quad Cities Classic). Somewhere along the way, Billy realized there had to be a way to honor them besides the varsity jackets with "Crew Mom" and "Crew Dad" the team gave them, nice as those were.
